

Youngstown native and Peace Corps Volunteer, Erik Hendel, is working to build a daycare facility in his adoptive South African village. In this village, most residents must travel to other towns for employment opportunities. If they have young children, they often have to leave their kids with other family members or neighbors. The parents have few other options, as there is no formal organization filling this need. Land in an easily accessible, central location in the village has been secured by a local group named Vikelani Abantwana Crèche, and blueprints to construct the 100 square-meter building were finalized in February. The plan is in place - now what is needed is money.
